

SCHEDULE A

FOR RESIDENTIAL CONSTRUCTION

In accordance with Article II of the National Agreement for Residential and Light Commercial Construction ("National Agreement") between the United Association and _____, Employer or Employer Association (Employer) who are signed to the current Collective Bargaining Agreement with one or more of the Participating Local Unions, this "Schedule A" is entered into on behalf of the undersigned signatories to the National Agreement and is applicable only for the territorial jurisdiction described in Section II below. The "Schedule A" shall identify the covered work, the applicable special conditions, wage rates and fringe benefit contributions that shall apply for all work performed in that territorial jurisdiction. An employer signatory to the National Agreement performing covered work other than that described in Section I and/or performing work in any territorial jurisdiction other than that described in Section II must execute a separate "Schedule A" covering such work.

I. SCOPE OF WORK

This "Schedule A" shall apply to all work relating to the installation of all heating, ventilating, air conditioning (HVAC), plumbing, and fire protection systems, including fixtures and equipment and/or related piping systems, and the handling of all piping, appurtenances and equipment thereto, when performed on the following:

- A. one or two family dwelling;
- B. all multiple family dwelling
- C. townhouses, condominiums and similar structures
- D. units which are permitted to have a single exterior up to and including four stories- Refer to Article IV, Special Conditions
- E. units stacked vertically up to and including four stories- Refer to Article IV, Special Conditions

This "Schedule A" shall also include any and all residential work, or work of a similar nature within the jurisdiction of the United Association, as mutually agreed to by the parties and as described in Section IV (Special Conditions).

II. TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION

The terms of this "Schedule A" shall apply to all work performed by the Employer (identify State or other geographic area or project, as applicable);

- A. For the State of Minnesota
- B. For the Geographic Area of the jurisdictional areas as designated under the wage and benefit structure for the participating local union
- C. For the Following Projects: _____

III. CLASSIFICATIONS OF EMPLOYEES

As defined in current Collective Bargained Agreements and Apprenticeship Agreements as per participating Local Unions

IV. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

The following special provisions or conditions apply to all work performed under this "Schedule A" in the Territorial Jurisdiction identified above:

- A. Appoint a Statewide Residential Representative (SRR) to be governed in accordance with the Minnesota Pipe Trades (MNPT) By-Laws.
- B. The duty of the SRR is to coordinate with the participating local unions as needs arise in the residential market.
- C. Members:
 - participation will be voluntary
 - dues and fringes reciprocate to the current local union and member
 - reciprocity in place through the Twin City Pipe Trades (TCPT)
- D. Article 1 Scope of Work is for residential construction only as defined under Article 1 Scope of work in Schedule A
- E. Procedure:
 - Contractor makes a request for Pipe Trades person to the SRR
 - SRR corresponds with participating locals the request from the contractor
 - Participating local unions pass on the request to their membership
 - Referral sent from the members local union to the SRR and then forwarded to the contractor
- F. Up to four-story multi-unit residence may be approved by the Local Union on a job-by-job basis according to territorial jurisdiction

V. WAGES AND FRINGE BENEFITS

Wage, fringe benefit rates, and territorial jurisdictional for the participating Local Unions will be attached to this document.

This agreement effective January 1, 2012 through December 31, 2013
